- Under Resource Collection, type in ESL in the search box.
- On the left side under the topic area, choose Adult ESL.
- Scroll down and under product type choose Instructional Material
- On the right side will now be all kinds of resources you can click on and peruse. My favorite: ESL Literacy Readers from Bow Valley College When you click on that, there is a blue "view resource box you click and it brings you to the readers.
- Scroll down under description and there's another text box that says ESL Literacy page and you click there.
- Then the fun begins. You scroll down and pick a level and see if it may meet the level of your students. Once you have level, pick a topic you like. Then you can print a master to make booklets for your students. And these are FREE. (Especially if the church lets you print them.) Can print different booklets for different levels of students.
- Also has Instructor Information
- That's just one of the ESL resources under instructional material. They also have curriculum, instructional video, lesson plan, and teaching strategy.
- There are many other topics to choose and products such as Informational material and professional development.
