REVIEW THE GOSPEL: Pictionary

We know how important the Gospel is and we need to be sure we understand important big ideas. Get some paper and play a game of Pictionary with your kids to lead them into a full understanding of the Gospel and what that means to them.

Draw the following words and have your kids guess what they are. Then, reveal how they fit into the gospel story.

pay ♦ Cross ♦ blood

Teach what we need to do:

pray ♦ gift ♦ choose ♦ clean
